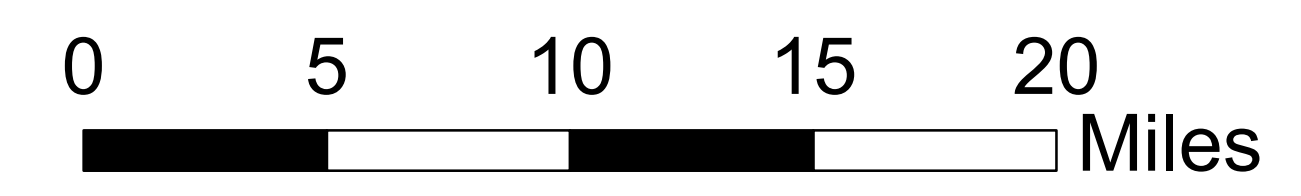

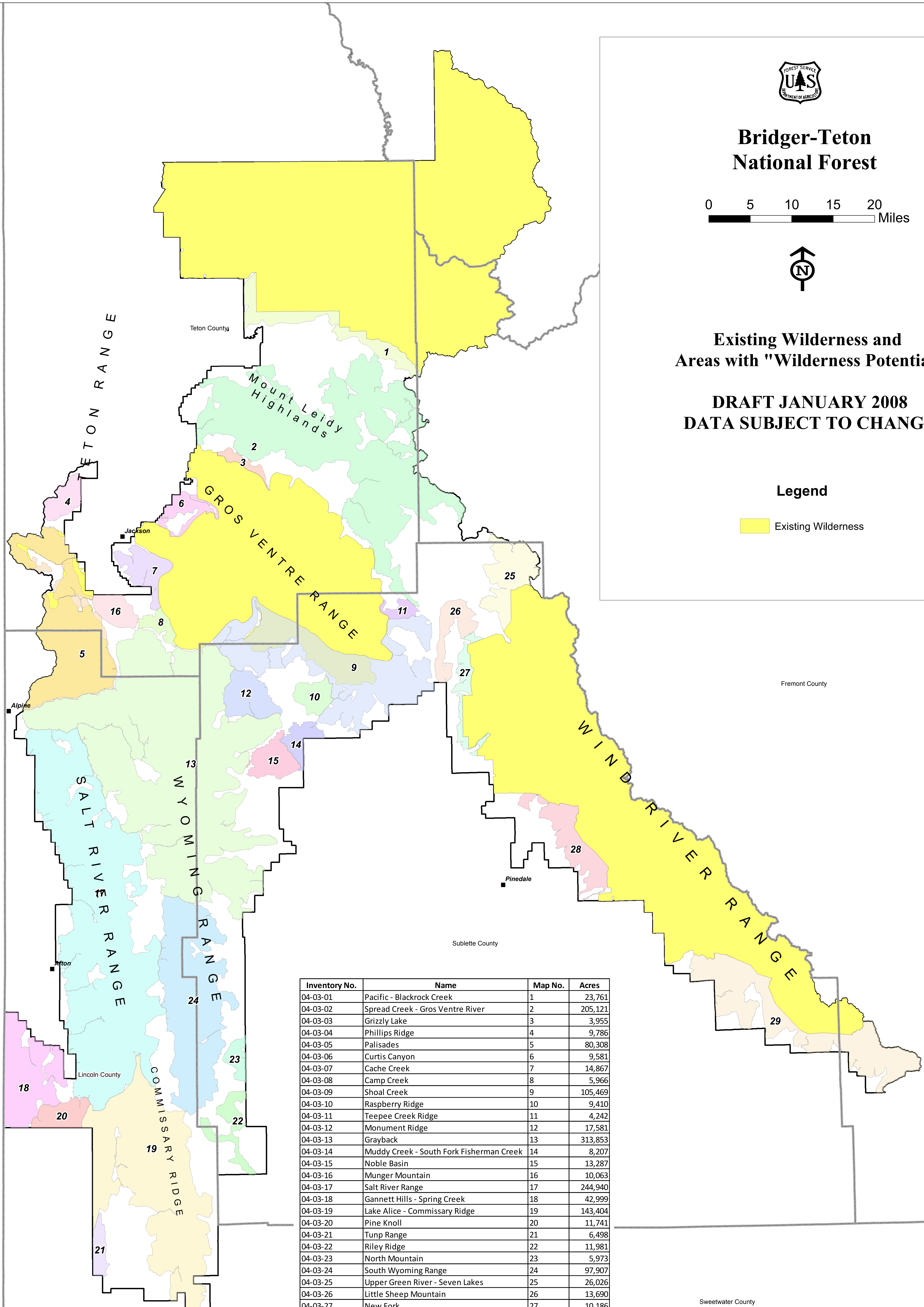


Existing Wilderness and Areas with "Wilderness Potential"
